DESCRIPTION OF ARTICLE(S):

One 18ky yellow gold, Van Cleef & Arpels, emerald and diamond brooch/pendant. The design consists of a cast and hand assembled quadrefoil bombe shaped brooch/pendant comprised of one (1) center round cut emerald surrounded by ten (10) round cut diamonds with a spray of four (4) round cut emeralds and four (4) tear drop emeralds outlined with one hundred and twenty-four (124) round cut diamonds mounted in prongs. The brooch/pendant measures 66.00 mm long x 64.00 mm wide. The back consists of a hinged double stem with a tube clasp and a concealed bail with safety bar. The brooch is finished with a high polish. The total gross weight of the brooch/pendant is 53.1 grams. Stamped Van Cleef & Arpels 19929.
